

List of accepted languages for KIIDs/KIDS

This section defines the list of languages that are accepted by the Competent Authority in each Member State for CBDF passports for UCITS.

This table also sets out whether the KIID/KID document is required to be submitted in one of the official languages of the relevant country, i.e., where a country is listed as 'Yes' then a KIID/KID in that language should be submitted as part of a passport notification.

Failure to upload a KIID/KID document in an official language, as per the below table, may lead to passporting applications being rejected.
